The Law Concerning Accessible Parking for People with Disabilities

In the City of Knoxville, be advised that it is:

- Illegal to park in a space designated for people with disabilities without a valid disabled parking hang tag (placard) or license plate.
 - Illegal to park in an access aisle (striped area) adjacent to a designated parking space.
 - Illegal to park in an accessible space if the person to whom the tag or plate is issued is not present.
 - Illegal to park in a way that blocks a ramp or curb cut intended to provide access to people with disabilities.
 - Violation subjects offender to a citation to City Court, a fine, and/or confiscation of hang tag.
